One of the 613 mitzvos is the prohibition against destroying even one stone from the Holy Temple, how then could Hashem have destroyed the entire Temple, and not just once, but twice?

But the answer is that the prohibition is against destroying for the sake of causing damage, not demolition for the sake of rebuilding. And since we know that the Third Temple will be greater in every way than the first two Temples, we can therefore reframe the entire Churban (Destruction) as part of a larger process of rebuilding.

And so it is with all of the pain and suffering that we have endured over the 2,000 years of exile.

We have to know that it is not wanton destruction, G-d forbid, but a process that can - and actually by definition - must lead to something greater than we have lost.

May we witness the rebuilding of the Holy Temple and our entire world immediately with Moshiach now.
