

Where do you find the concept in the Torah?

Calling a woman by her first name: The Gemara (Sotah 2a) relates, "Forty days before a child is born, they declare in Heaven 'Bas Ploni L'Ploni, the daughter of So-and-so will marry So-and-so." The mefarshim ask, why do they only mention the names of the males, not the female? Wouldn't it make more sense to declare 'Plonis L'Ploni', thus calling the girl by her name? Several mefarshim answer that this teaches us that it is not appropriate to refer to a woman by her first name. (Ben Yehoyada 2a; Igra D'Kallah, Lech Lecha 17:15)
