



## **Handshakes**

4. It is prohibited for an unrelated man and woman to shake each other's hand, even if the intent is for business and not of a personal nature. (Sefer Chassidim 1090; Od Yosef Chai, Shoftim; Pri Deah 195; Shiurei Shevet Halevi 195:74; Kreina D'Igresa 2:119; Igros Moshe EH 1:56 and OC 1:113; Be'er Moshe 4:130; Moadim U'zmanim 4, 316:1; Teshuvos V'hanhagos 1:774)

Hence, if a *frum* person comes across someone secular/non-Jewish who extends their hand, the *frum* person may not shake it.
