



Looking at a Computer Together

7. When an unrelated man and woman need to view something together, they should maintain adequate distance between them - and should certainly not lean over one another - to avoid the possibility of inadvertent contact.

8. When an unrelated man and woman must review something together on a computer, it is preferable that the document/information should be printed out first. This makes it easier to maintain a proper distance. (In addition, it prevents familiarity during the review.)
