



Where it is Forbidden Even to Glance

4. It is always forbidden even to merely glance at areas of a woman's body that are usually covered, and certainly when she is dressed inappropriately. (*Pri Megadim*, MZ 75:1; *Mishnah Berurah* *ibid*:7; *Igros Moshe* OC 1:40, and EH 3:13; see *Chut Shani* EH p. 42)

5. Similarly, one must be stringent and refrain from even glancing at a woman who is dressed in a particularly elegant manner. (*Chut Shani* EH p. 42; *Levushah Shel Torah* 70:3; *She'eilas Yaakov* 51; see *Malbushei Mordechai*, *Tzniyus* 6:10)

6. If one derives pleasure from glancing at a member of the opposite gender, or if it leads towards inappropriate thoughts, it is always prohibited. (*Chut Shani* EH p. 42; *Igros Moshe* 1:40)
