

Mussar Perspective / An Adam Chashuv

7. The *poskim* write that even in an instance where *halachah* permits one to glance at a woman, it is appropriate from a *mussar* perspective to be stringent and refrain from seeing. (*Pri Megadim, MZ* 75:1; *Mishnah Berurah ibid*:7; see *Chut Shani EH p. 42*)

8. Similarly, an *adam chashuv* (person of stature) must always be stringent and avoid even seeing women. (*Pri Megadim, MZ* 75:1; *Mishnah Berurah ibid:7; see Chut Shani EH p. 42*)
