



Mirrors and Photos

9. The prohibition against looking at a woman also applies when one does not see her directly, but rather in the mirror, in a photo (both paper or electronic), video, etc. (*Shevet Halevi* 2:2; *Minchas Yitzchok* vol. 2, 84:9; see *Divrei Malkiel* 3:58)

10. Certainly, viewing inappropriate photos, videos, etc., entails a very severe prohibition. (*Divrei Malkiel* 3:58; *Be'er Moshe* 3:154 and 4:147; *Yisroel Kedoshim* 6)

- Special vigilance must be taken at the workplace not to order, and certainly not to read, catalogs or other work-related material that feature inappropriate images, which are forbidden to be viewed. In the event that there is a pressing need for one to view such material, he must make sure that the inappropriate image is removed prior to being viewed.
