



Responsibility for Products Sold

21. It is forbidden to manufacture or sell clothing to Jewish women that is not *tznius*. (Doing so could be a violation of several severe *issurim* including “*mesayei’a l’dvar aveirah*,” “*machshil es harabbim*,” among others.) Therefore, a clothing store must make sure that all the clothing they sell is in accordance with *halachah* and the standards of *tznius*. (See *Shu”t Shevet Halevi, Chelek 2, Siman 62, and Chelek 4, Siman 1; Drashos Shevet Halevi, Chelek 2, p. 123.*)

22. Storeowners who sell products or items that were manufactured by non-Jewish companies and have inappropriate pictures on the packaging must make sure that the pictures are covered so that they do not cause customers to transgress the *issur* of seeing forbidden sights.
