

Protecting Our Thoughts

Introduction-*Hirhur* (Thoughts)

The Gemara derives from the pasuk (Bamidbar 15:39) "V'lo sasuru acharei levav'chem v'acharei eineichem, do not pursue the temptations of your heart and eyes" that one is prohibited to have hirhurei aveirah, thoughts of sin. This means that men and women are forbidden from thinking thoughts about sinful acts or even merely about forming a close relationship. (Berachos 12b; Sefer Hachinuch, Mitzvah 387)

There is also another pasuk (Devarim 23:10) that states, "V'nishmarta mikol davar ra, you should be vigilant to avoid all evil." From here we derive that a man may not think any thought that can lead toward pitfalls. This prohibition includes both inappropriate thoughts and any act that can lead one toward inappropriate

thoughts. (Kesubos 46a; Avodah Zarah 20b)
