



### Permitted Scenarios

8. If one wants to daven, recite a *brachah*, or say any other *devarim sheb'kedushah* in such a place, ideally, he should turn his entire body to face a different direction. Closing one's eyes or turning only his face to the side is not sufficient. (*Mishnah Berurah 75:1; Beur Halachah ad loc.*)

9. If, however, one cannot turn his entire body and he has no other choice, he may suffice with closing his eyes and making sure not to look. (*ibid*)
