



To Which Women Does the Prohibition Apply?

25. The prohibition to daven or learn while hearing a woman sing applies to both an unrelated woman as well as to one's own wife or any other family member, such as a sister or daughter. (*Shulchan Aruch and Rema OC 75:3*)

Multiple Women Singing Together

26. Similarly, if one hears a few women singing together, he may not daven or learn. (*Shevet Halevi 5:197; Halichos Shlomo – Tefillah ch. 20 Dvar Halachah 20; Levushah Shel Torah 75; Rav Y.E. Forchheimer shlita, quoted in Kovetz Etz Chaim*)
