



Obeying One's Parents Regarding Where to Work

11. If a young man has the option of working at a lower-paying job in a more appropriate workplace environment, or at a higher-paying job with more spiritual challenges, and his parents are urging him to take the second job so that he can earn more - if he would rather work in the lower-paying job because it presents fewer temptations, he should speak to a competent *Rav* to determine whether, due to the *chiyuv of kibbutz av va'eim*, he is required to take the second, more spiritually dangerous job.

The same applies to a young woman in such a situation. (*Rav Yechiel Michel Steinmetz shlita*)
