



An Inappropriate Party

7. If one knows that a particular event will not be held in accordance with proper *tznius* standards, they should not attend, even if it is held for the purpose of a mitzvah. (*Sefer Chassidim* 393; see *Taharas Yom Tov* from p. 126)

8. One who works for a company managed by gentiles or secular Jews – who will be upset if he/she does not attend their party (and there is no plausible excuse to rationalize missing the event) – must consult a *posek*.

Note: It is important to bear in mind – when hosting a larger conference or party for one's employees, partners, business associates, etc. with catering and entertainment – that it is the host's responsibility to ensure that the event is organized in an appropriate manner, in accordance with the *halachos* of *tznius*. Otherwise, the host can, *ch"v*, fall under the category of "*machti es harabbim*," causing the public to sin.
